

Enrol in your courses

It is important that you plan your enrolment each year to make sure you choose the right courses (subjects) to study, at the right time, so you can graduate from your degree when you plan to.

Once you know which courses you will study, you need to finalise your enrolment by selecting your courses and class times in **USC Central**. Visit the [Academic Calendar](#) for key enrolment dates.

STEP 1 – Plan your courses

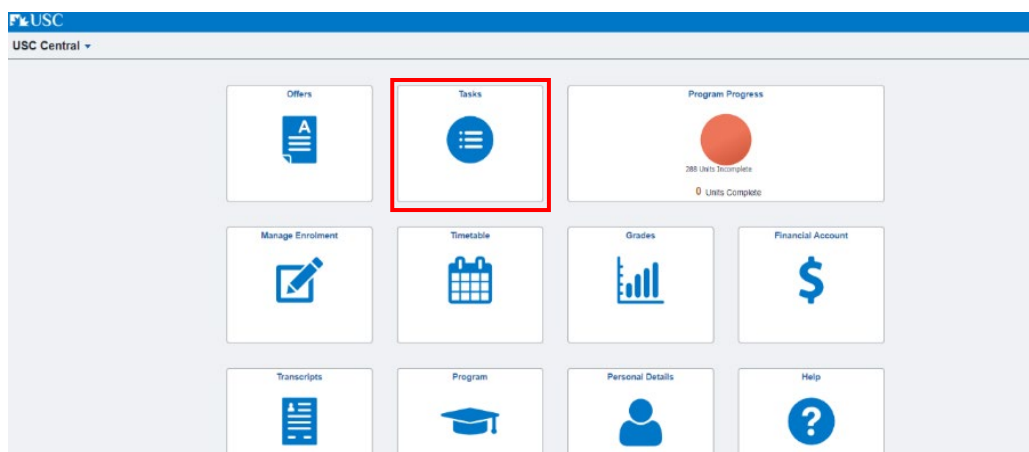
Before you can enrol, you need to plan which courses to study and when. UniSC Adelaide will provide you with a **study sequence** for your program which shows when your courses are offered.

If you are a Student visa holder, you are required to enrol in such a way that allows you to complete your program by the end date of your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). For most students this will require you to enrol as per the full-time study sequence for your program.

There may be instances where you cannot enrol into a full-time study load, e.g. if you have received credit for prior learning or course availability. Contact UniSC Adelaide Student Services if you have questions about which courses to enrol in or how your enrolment may impact your Student visa.

STEP 2 – Complete your pre-enrolment tasks

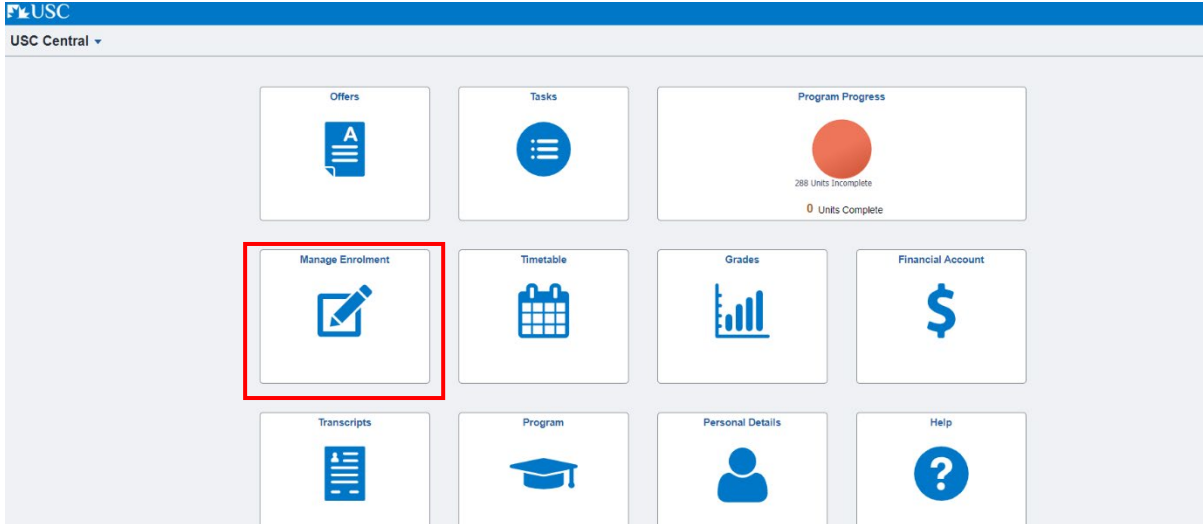
1. Log in to [USC Central](#) using the username and password provided to you after you accepted your offer to study at UniSC. If you have difficulties logging in, contact UniSC Adelaide Student Services.
2. Select **Tasks** and complete your pre-enrolment tasks.



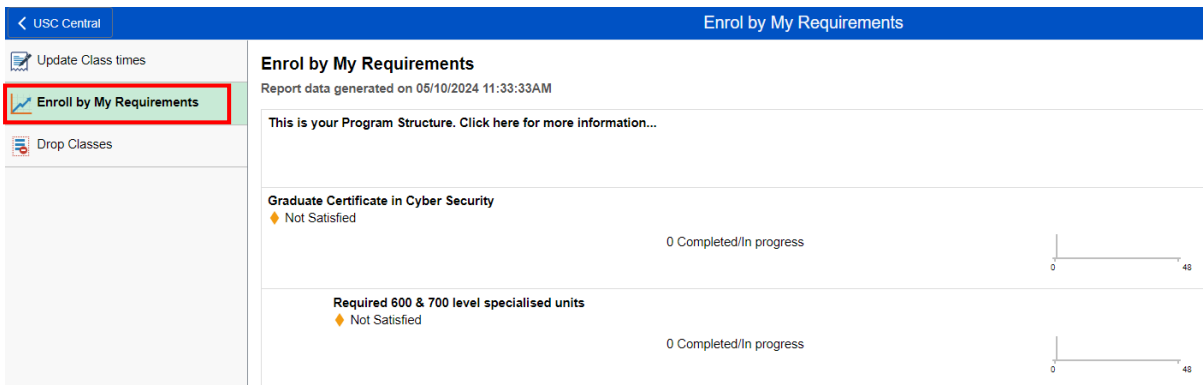
STEP 3 – Enrol in your courses

Note key enrolment dates in the [Academic Calendar](#).

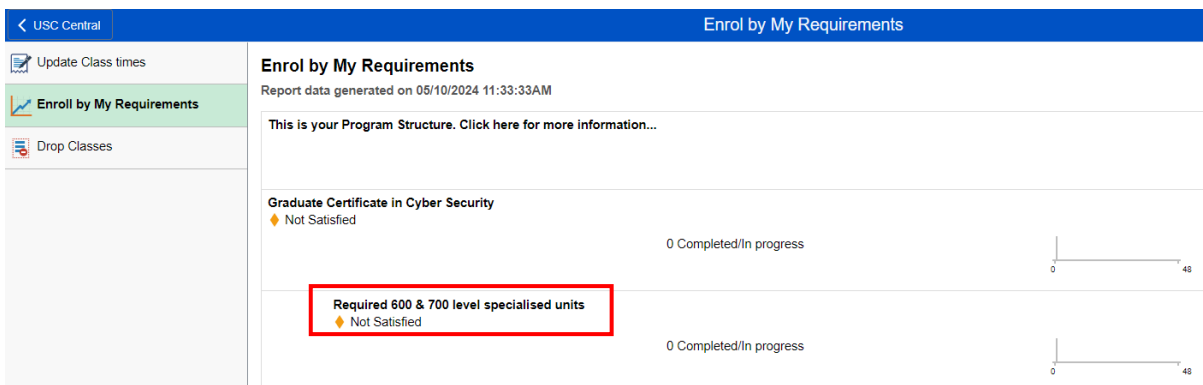
1. On your dashboard, select **Manage Enrolment**.

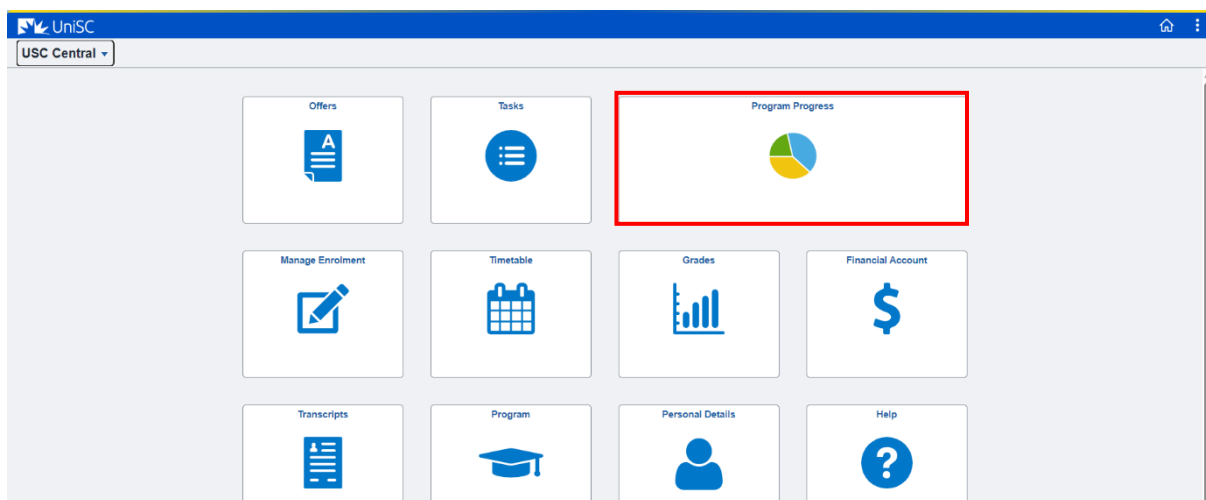
10. Select **Return to Enrol by My requirements** and repeat steps 4-9 to enrol in your other courses.
