HIKE: Explore the Sunshine Coast hinterland, hike one of our popular mountains, visit waterfalls or go on a walk through subtropical rainforests.

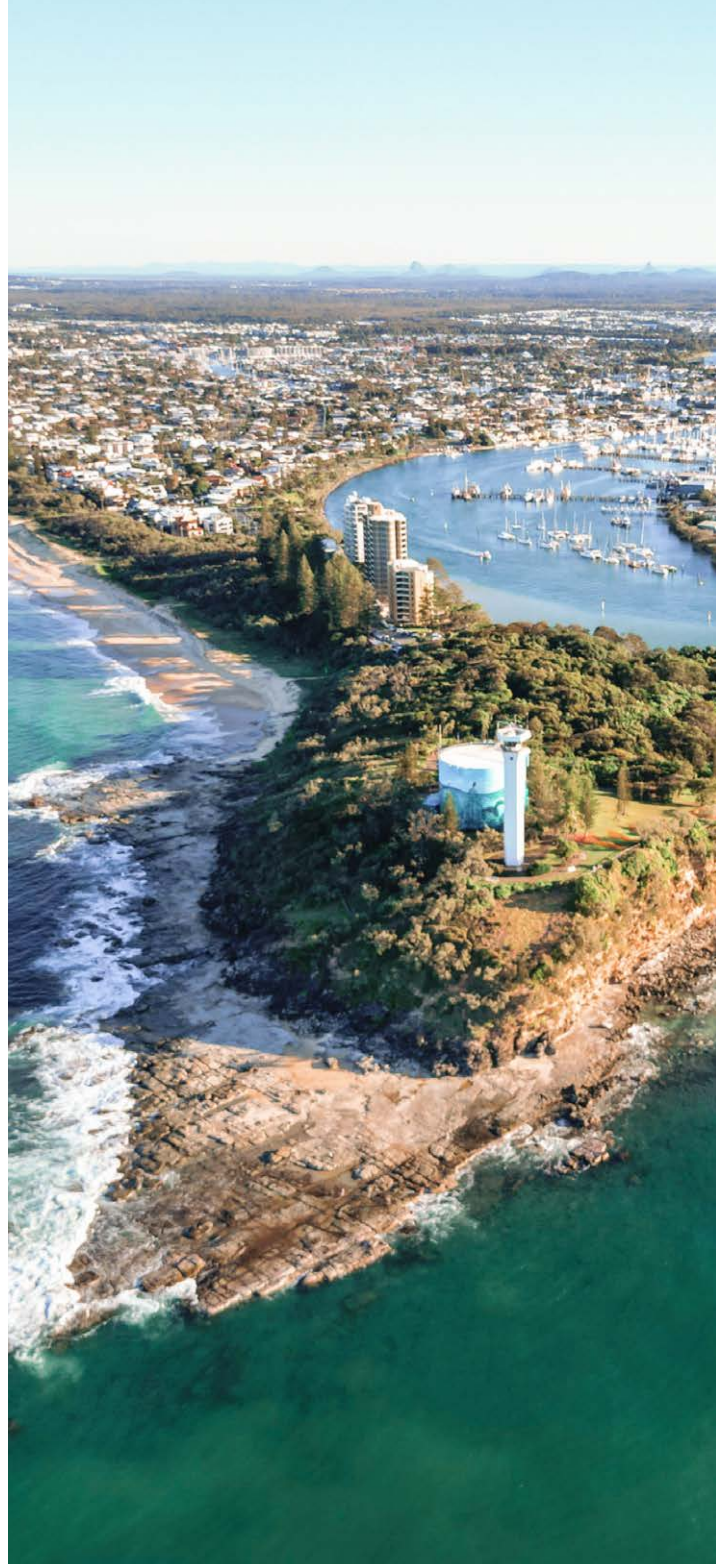

Diploma program

Diploma program

Complement your current studies, improve your career prospects and enhance your English language fluency and cross-cultural knowledge.

By choosing UniSC's Diploma program, on successful completion, you will graduate from UniSC with a recognised qualification from the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

Use your overseas study experience to gain an international perspective, a cultural experience and make yourself stand out from the crowd.

If you are eligible, you could earn up to 50 percent credit for prior study and complete the Diploma in one semester.

The courses on offer within the Diploma are taken directly from several of UniSC's undergraduate programs, you will enrol in classes with local students, study at undergraduate Bachelor level and have the flexibility to choose your preferred courses.

Complete a Diploma in one semester




UniSC offers eligible students the opportunity to apply for their preferred diploma with up to 50 percent credit transfer*, which means students could complete the program in one semester.

- ✓ Students can apply for credit for up to four courses (48 units)
- ✓ If four courses of credit transfer are granted, students will be required to successfully complete the remaining four courses (48 units) at UniSC to graduate
- ✓ Eligibility of credit transfer can only be assessed once an application has been received. If you are currently enrolled at a tertiary institution, you need to check with your home institution about the possibility of credit transfer for courses studied at UniSC.

* To be eligible, students with recognised prior tertiary studies must apply for and receive credit transfer.

Choose your courses and have them approved by UniSC and your home institution before you arrive.

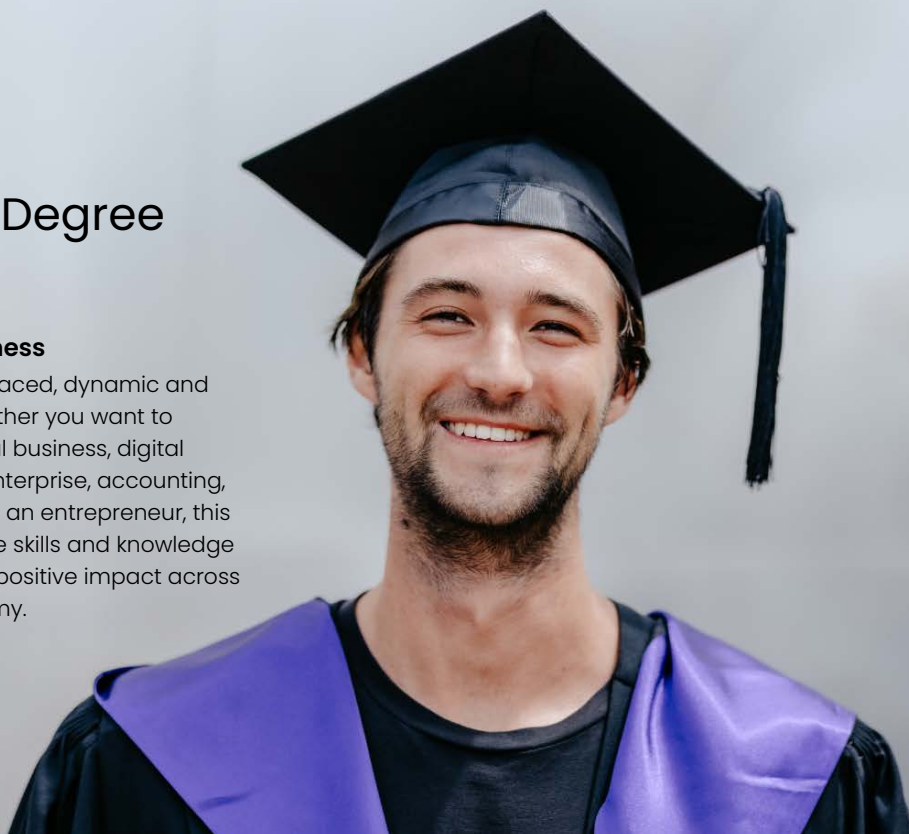

Bachelor Degree program

Bachelor of Business

Business is a fast-paced, dynamic and exciting world. Whether you want to work in international business, digital marketing, social enterprise, accounting, management or as an entrepreneur, this degree provides the skills and knowledge needed to make a positive impact across a changing economy.



You have the option to complete this degree program in as little as two semesters (one year full-time study) if you have previously completed similar tertiary study. UniSC can credit up to 120 ECTS (four semesters) of your home bachelor studies towards the Bachelor of Business degree.

With full credit transfer you will only study eight courses (four courses per semester) at UniSC. If you have already finished introductory or second year level courses at your home university you may not have to study similar courses at UniSC again.

You may be able to choose advanced elective courses from majors such as:

Business Administration
Digital Futures
Economics and Finance
Human Resource Management
Marketing
Small Business Management
Tourism, Leisure and Event Management

You can start the UniSC degree during or after you have completed your home Bachelor degree.

If your home university provides credit transfer* for your UniSC studies you may be able to complete both degrees in the same time period – giving you a double degree!

You can start your UniSC degree program in the summer semester (Semester 1) or winter semester (Semester 2). You can choose from a range of courses depending on the credit transfer UniSC awards you.

Studying two semesters on the Sunshine Coast will allow you to experience the Australian culture, enhance your English language skills and will give you a competitive advantage in the global business environment.

Master degrees

Program structure for postgraduate business degrees

The UniSC Master programs listed in this guide are generally three study periods (six sessions) in duration.

However, you may be able to complete a UniSC Master degree in a minimum of one study period (two sessions) if you are enrolled in a relevant Master program at your home university.



UniSC may be able to credit up to 60 ECTS (four sessions) of your Master studies towards the UniSC Master degrees. If your home university also provides credit transfer for your UniSC studies you may be able to complete both Master degrees in the same time period—giving you a double degree!

All the listed UniSC Master programs are coursework only and do not contain a thesis or internship component. The courses are practice oriented and contain assignment work, such as essays, reports and presentations. You can start your UniSC degree program in your summer semester (UniSC Session 2) or winter semester (UniSC Session 6) and choose from a range of courses (conditional on the credit transfer awarded and the courses offered in the sessions at UniSC).

Admission requirements

For entry into the Master programs you will need to meet the relevant academic, english and application requirements. This includes holding an approved relevant Bachelor degree, as well as an English language certificate. For the MBA you will also need evidence of at least two years relevant full-time work or other relevant experience.

The Master of International Business (MIntBus) at UniSC generally contains 12 courses which can be completed within three full-time semesters (two sessions).

The program contains six required and six elective courses including Strategic Management, Marketing, Managing Across Global Cultures and International Trade and Finance. You can complete the MIntBus within one semester (two sessions) if you completed tertiary studies at a similar level at your home university.

Master of Management (MMgt)

Location: Sunshine Coast

The Master of Management (MMgt) gives you a complete theoretical foundation in all areas of management, including finance, informatics and marketing. This program has 16 courses in total, of which 11 are required and five are elective courses. However, if you have completed a Bachelor degree in the field of Business you may receive four courses credit.

You may be able to receive additional credit of eight courses if you have completed similar studies at Master level at your home university.

A full credit transfer would allow you to complete the MMgt within one semester (two sessions).

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) provides you with the opportunity to increase and deepen your range of management skills.

This program has 12 courses, of which eight are required and four are elective courses. The courses cover the latest trends and influences in business and build on your skills in critical thinking and analysis, which you can apply in project work.

You may be able to complete the UniSC MBA in one full-time semester (two sessions) if you also have completed similar studies at Master level at your home university.

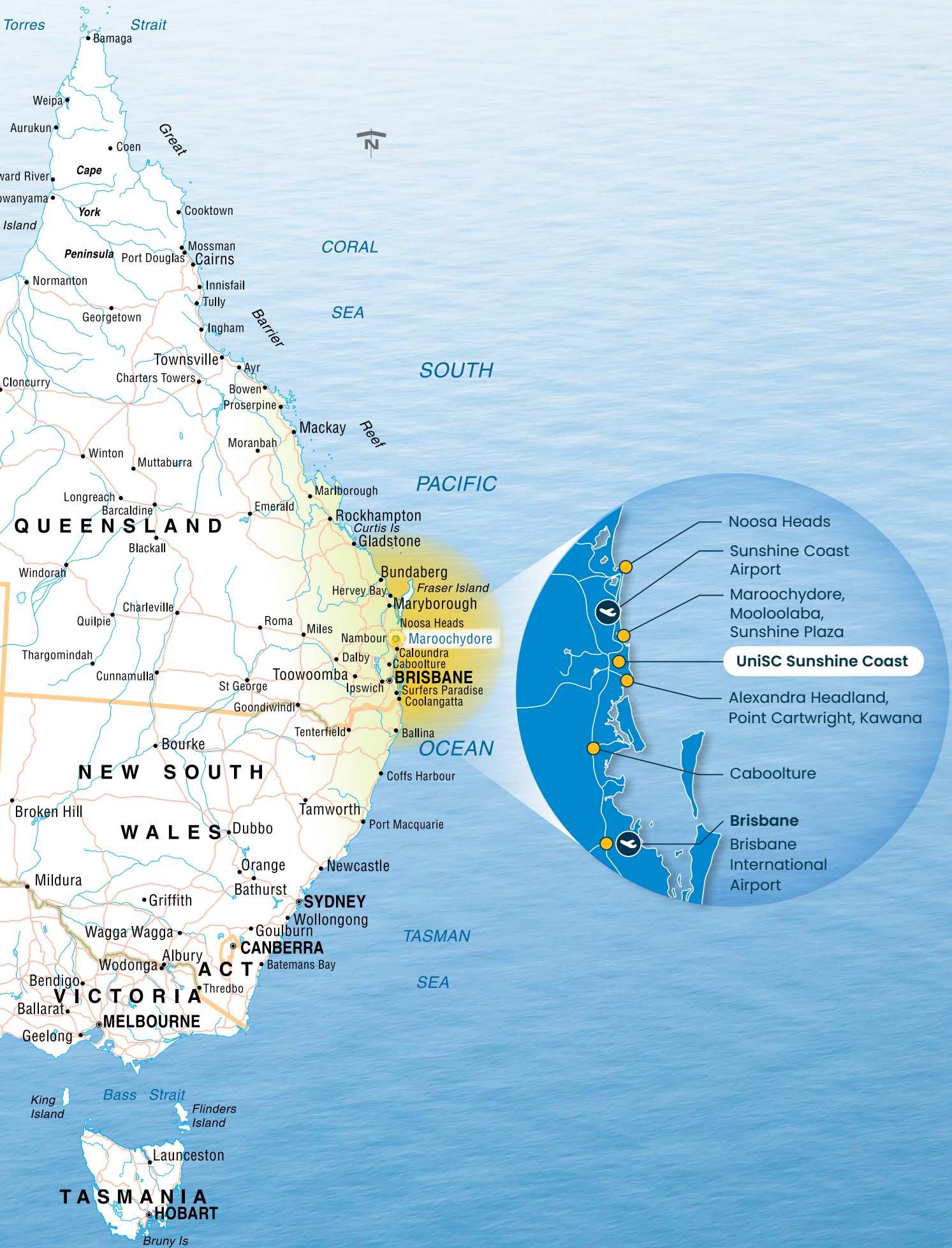

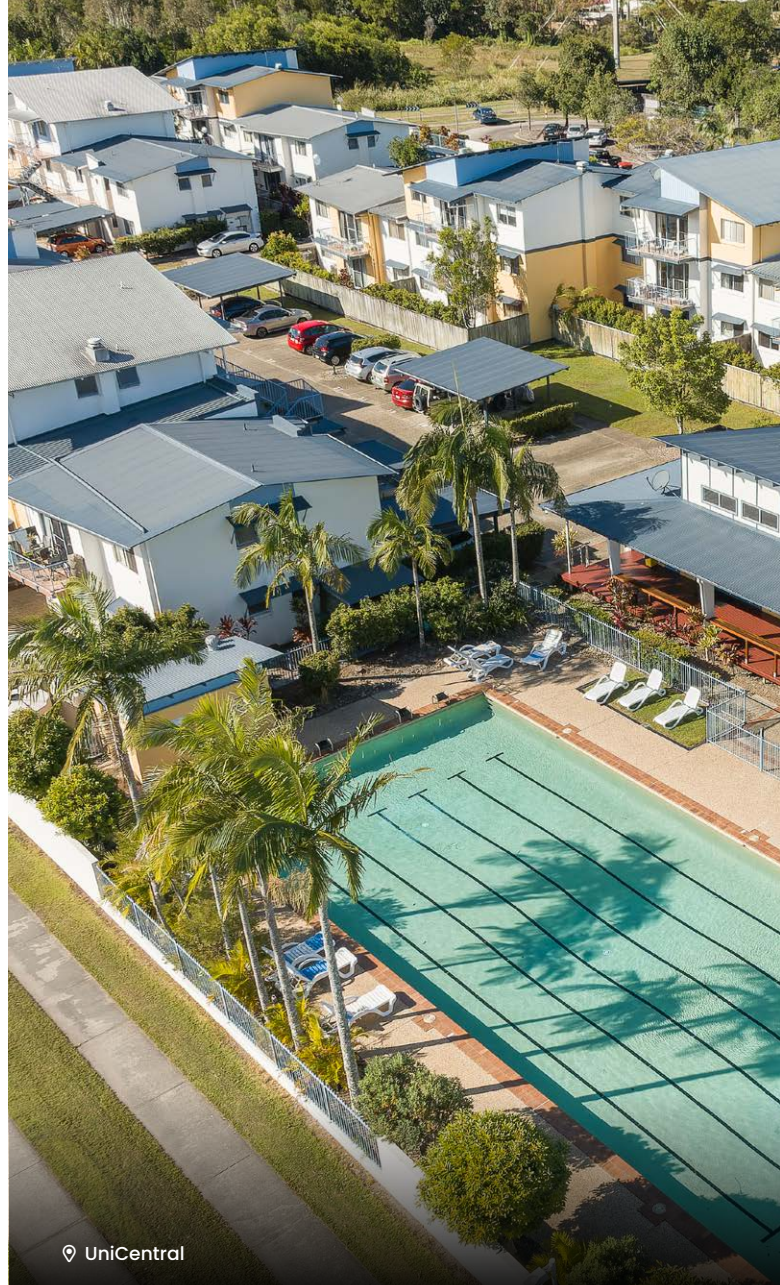

UniCentral offers four-share accommodation in modern, self-contained apartments. Each unit has a shared lounge, kitchen and laundry, and a courtyard or balcony. Each private bedroom has a double bed, bathroom, telephone, study desk and chair, internet connection, free UniSC intranet, and an intercom.

Facilities include:

- six-lane, 25-metre swimming pool, tennis/ basketball court, and a volleyball court
- outdoor recreational area with barbecues and a recreational pavilion with pool tables, table tennis, and more
- on-site managers and night security.



Transport

The Sunshine Coast is also an ideal base for exploring Australia's big cities, the Outback or the tropics. Brisbane, the capital of Queensland, is just over one hour away by car, and there are public transport connections from our Sunshine Coast campus.

Public transport

Public bus services operate between UniSC's bus interchange and coastal communities, giving you access to local beaches, shopping centres, restaurants and the nightlife of the Sunshine Coast. From UniSC's bus interchange, you can use an integrated bus and rail service to travel around the region.

Airport connections

UniSC is less than 30 minutes by car from the Sunshine Coast Airport and around 75 minutes from Brisbane international and domestic airports. Airport transfers can be arranged upon request with local providers (charges apply). Sunshine Coast Airport has direct flights to Sydney (1.5 hours), Melbourne (2.5 hours) and New Zealand (three hours). Brisbane has both domestic and international airports, meaning you have easy access to explore Australia and overseas!

Getting around campus

The UniSC Sunshine Coast campus is easily accessible by public transport and private transport. Many students opt to walk or ride to and from campus. With easy access between buildings, students can get to and from classes in a timely manner. Even choose to rent a bike from the local student groups. The surrounding suburb of Sippy Downs has plenty of amenities and services including restaurants, cafes, grocery stores and health facilities.

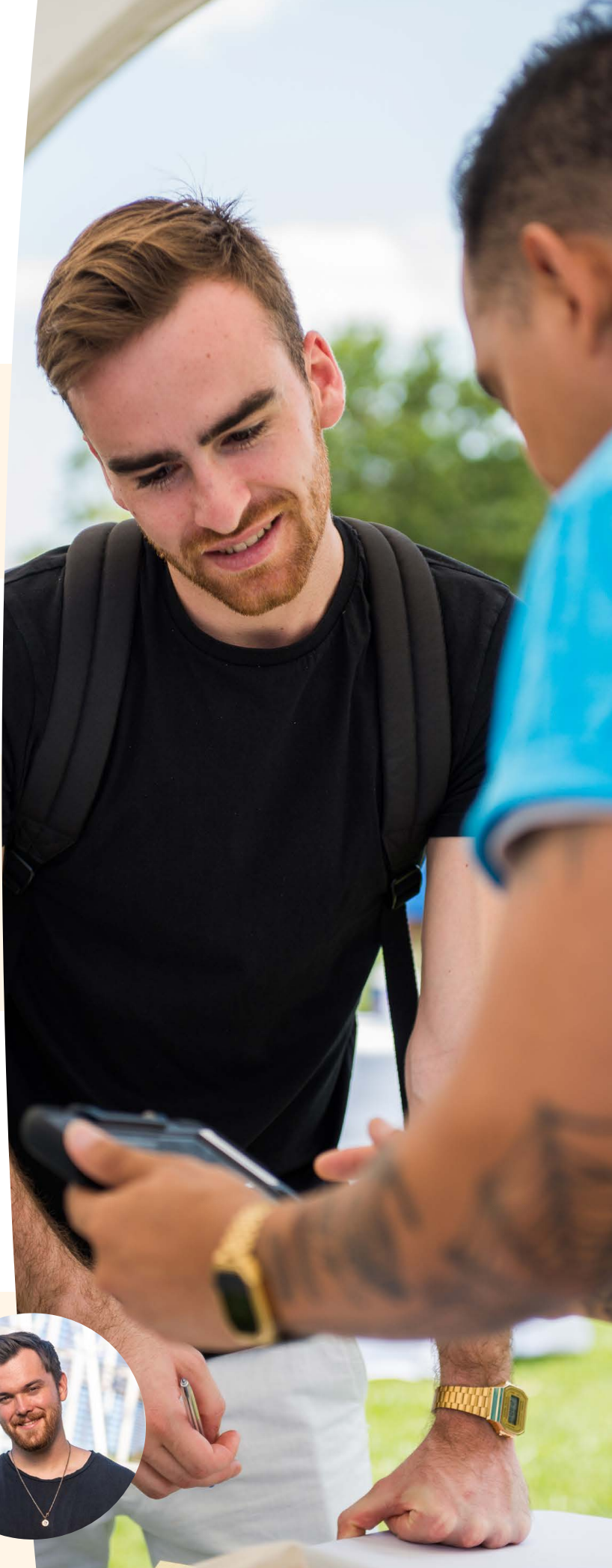

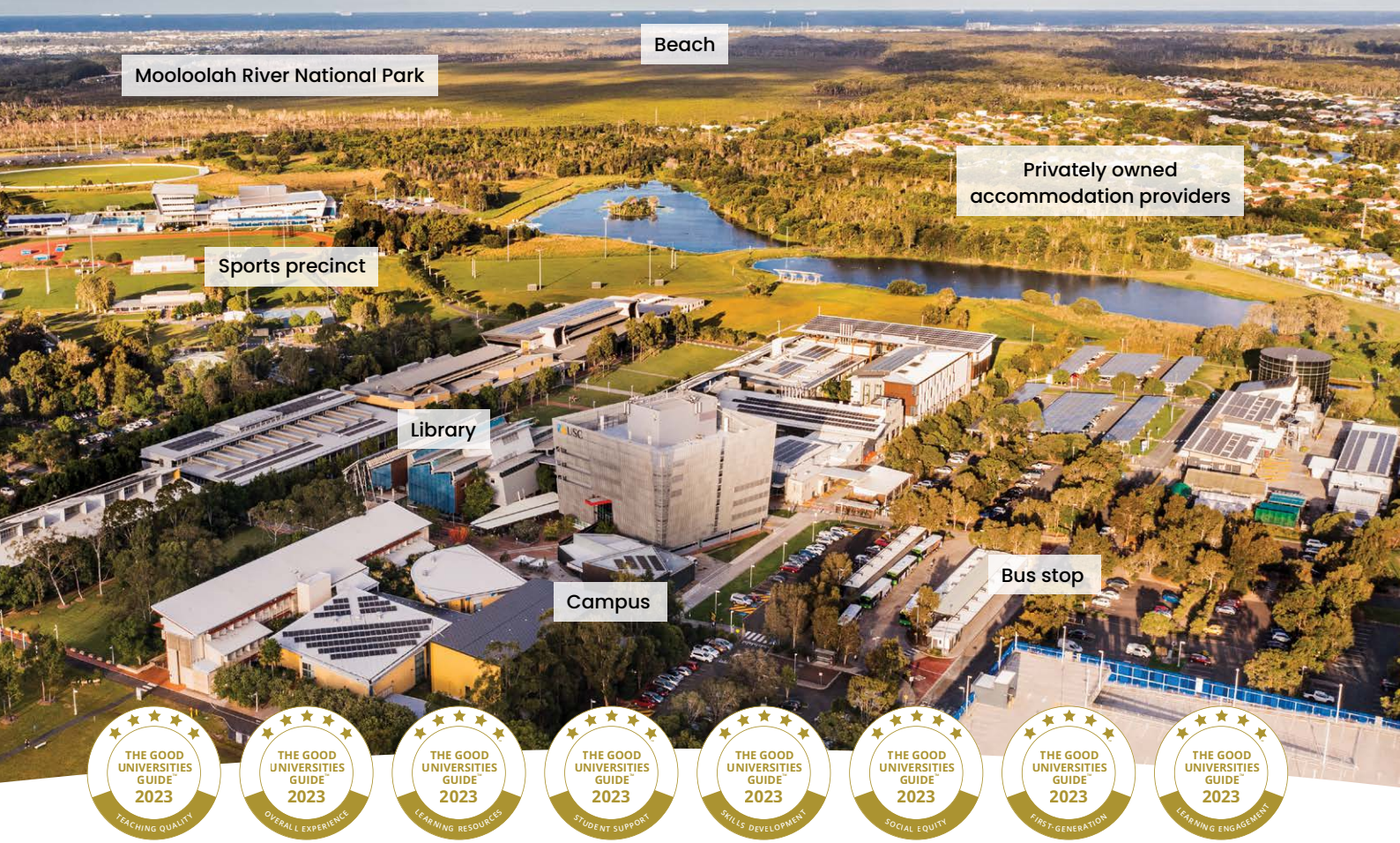
